Presidential Museum Fifth Anniversary Photo Op Monday, April 19 at 10:30 a.m.

SPRINGFIELD - The Abraham Lincoln Presidential Museum will celebrate its fifth anniversary with a special cake cutting by a Lincoln presenter and a brief program on Monday, April 19 at 10:30 a.m. in the Presidential Museum Plaza. Any paid visitors are invited to attend and sample a piece of anniversary cake.

The Abraham Lincoln Presidential Museum opened on April 19, 2005 with a ceremony attended by then President George W. Bush, First Lady Laura Bush, then U.S. Senator Barack Obama, numerous other dignitaries, approximately 25,000 spectators, and more than 400 members of the news media from the U.S. and abroad. Since its opening, the Museum has welcomed more than 2,235,000 visitors and its average annual attendance of 436,000 makes it the most popular Presidential Library and Museum in the nation.
